

Bridge construction to shut down I-20's Cooper Street exits in Arlington starting today

The Interstate 20 cloverleaf exits and entrances at Cooper Street/FM157 in [Arlington](#) will be closed for bridge construction from 9 a.m. Monday to 5 a.m. Thursday.

According to the Texas Department of Transportation, drivers on I-20 will be able to reach Cooper Street by using the "I-20/FM157 signalized intersections on the frontage roads," and drivers on Cooper Street/FM157 will be able to get onto I-20 via the same intersections.

During the closure, traffic on the Cooper Street/FM 157 bridge will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

The \$3 million bridge project will ultimately add one traffic lane in each direction to the bridge as well as left turn lanes. According to TxDOT, the project is scheduled for completion "by winter/spring 2011."
