REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING APRIL 25 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY

What: The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting to discuss upcoming steps in the regional water planning process for Region C. Among other agenda items, the RCWPG *will take action* on the addition of wholesale water providers in Region C; recommendations for unique stream segments and policy topics to be included in the Region C Initially Prepared Plan; and proposed strategies to meet water needs.

At the meeting, the planning group will *discuss* revised survey questions for the Infrastructure Financing Survey; review a draft layout of the May/June newsletter; and receive an update from consultants on the overall status of the Region C Initially Prepared Plan.

Members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting and participate in a public comment session during the meeting.

About RCWPG: The RCWPG is one of 16 regional water planning groups selected by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) to help develop a comprehensive state water plan for Texas over the next 50 years, as mandated by Senate Bill 1 (SB 1). Each water planning group is responsible for preparing and adopting a regional water plan for its area. The RCWPG is made up of 19 members representing 11 different interest groups.

About Region C: Region C is made up of all or part of 16 counties in North Texas: Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Freestone, Grayson, Henderson, Jack, Kaufman, Navarro, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise.
