REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING OCTOBER 10 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY

What: The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting to discuss upcoming steps in the regional water planning process for Region C. Among other agenda items, the RCWPG will *discuss* responses to comments received on Region C's Initially Prepared Plan, the timing of water management strategies included in the draft plan, supplemental work recently submitted by the RCWPG to the Texas Water Development Board, Region C's infrastructure financing survey and report, plans for the RCWPG's next newsletter and the schedule to complete the 2006 Region C Water Plan.

The RCWPG will also take *action* on the possible designation of unique stream segments for the region.

Members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting and participate in a public comment session during the meeting.

About RCWPG: The RCWPG is one of 16 regional water planning groups selected by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) to help develop a comprehensive state water plan for Texas over the next 50 years, as mandated by Senate Bill 1 (SB 1). Each water planning group is responsible for preparing and adopting a regional water plan for its area. The RCWPG is made up of 19 members representing 11 different interest groups.

About Region C: Region C is made up of all or part of 16 counties in North Texas: Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Freestone, Grayson, Henderson, Jack, Kaufman, Navarro, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise.
