



**RESOLUTION IN HONOR OF
DEPARTING MEMBER DANNY VANCE**

Resolution No. 12-2

WHEREAS, the Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) respectfully notes the recent decision by Danny Vance to step down from his position on the RCWPG; and

WHEREAS, during his 40-plus year career with the Trinity River Authority, from which he retired in 2011, Danny helped oversee the creation of four regional potable water systems and three regional wastewater systems, as well as significant improvements to all nine regional systems, and the Trinity River Authority became the largest river authority in Texas, with major increases to its assets and annual operating budget; and

WHEREAS, Danny served as president of the Texas Water Conservation Association and earned recognition from many for his leadership in balancing the need for adequate water supplies for a growing population with the environmental needs of the Trinity River Basin and the Trinity Bay and Estuary; and

WHEREAS, throughout more than three five-year cycles of the Regional Water Planning process, Danny has served as a valued member of the RCWPG, contributing passionately to the planning effort and ably representing the interests of river authorities; and

WHEREAS, during his many years of service in these and other capacities, Danny dedicated significant efforts to ensuring that North Central Texas residents and businesses would have a safe, plentiful water supply for many decades to come; and

WHEREAS, Danny worked tirelessly and cheerfully, but largely without public recognition, for his many public service efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Region C Water Planning Group, that we commend Danny Vance for his selfless service to the community, and we proclaim that his contributions are visibly reflected both in the Region C Water Plan and countless other endeavors benefiting the entire North Central Texas region and its millions of residents.
