**REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING  
MONDAY, AUGUST 5 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY**

**What:** The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting as part of the regional water planning process in North Central Texas. The RCWPG is currently working to develop an updated 2016 Region C Water Plan that includes recommended water management strategies to meet the region's water supply needs through 2070.

*Key action items* for the meeting, among others, include:

- Considering approval of revised population and municipal water demand projections for the North Central Texas region through 2070
- Considering appointment of representatives to mediate on behalf of the RCWPG to resolve the interregional conflict between the 2011 Region C and Region D Water Plans concerning Marvin Nichols Reservoir
- Considering authorization of the RCWPG chairman to participate on a stakeholder committee to develop prioritization standards for the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas and the State Water Implementation Revenue Fund for Texas, provided that the constitutional amendment proposed by SJR 1 passes on Nov. 5

The meeting will also include a guest presentation by State Climatologist Dr. John Nielsen-Gammon, who will provide an update on the drought and related issues.

**Members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting and participate in a public comment session during the meeting.**

**About RCWPG:** The RCWPG is one of 16 regional water planning groups selected by the TWDB to help develop a comprehensive state water plan for Texas over the next 50+ years. Each water planning group is responsible for preparing and adopting a regional water plan for its area. The RCWPG is made up of 22 members representing a variety of interest groups, and Region C is made up of all or part of 16 counties in North Central Texas: Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Freestone, Grayson, Henderson (Trinity River Basin portion), Jack, Kaufman, Navarro, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise.
