In order to identify the water supply, treatment and transmission options viable to meet the future needs of Chatfield WSC and its extended service area, including parts of eastern Navarro County, the Chatfield WSC will conduct a water supply feasibility study. This study will include an inventory of existing conditions and forecast of future needs, water demands as well as infrastructure needs, a development of viable alternatives, an evaluation and cost comparison of alternatives, and selection of preferred alternative(s). In addressing the alternatives the most cost effective solution for meeting the future water needs of the planning area will be determined for implementation in the future.

The Chatfield WSC is in the process of applying for a regional water planning grant from the Texas Water Development Board for the proposed service area.
