REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING MONDAY, JUNE 8 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY

What: The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting as part of the regional water planning process in North Central Texas. Included among the Planning Group's *action items* at the meeting: approval to authorize the Chairman to amend the contracts from the recently completed Special Studies; approval to authorize the Chairman to formally respond to the Texas Water Development Board regarding the request for a three-month extension for the submittal of the Initially Prepared Plan and Final Plan; and approval of the Summer 2009 Region C newsletter.

Included among the RCWPG's *discussion items* for the meeting are the following topics: an overview of the project schedule; a presentation on the recent Texas Water Conservation Day in the Texas Legislature; a progress report on the review and update of Region C's population and demand projections; a progress report on the update of existing supplies including Water Availability Models and Managed Available Groundwater; a report on results of the recent survey sent to all Water User Groups, Wholesale Water Providers and other entities; an outline of the general approach and timeline for several special studies; a presentation on the criteria by which water management strategies will be analyzed; an update on media outreach strategies; and the formation of a committee to evaluate ecologically unique stream segments.

Members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting and participate in a public comment session during the meeting.

About RCWPG: The RCWPG is one of 16 regional water planning groups selected by the TWDB to help develop a comprehensive state water plan for Texas over the next 50 years. Each water planning group is responsible for preparing and adopting a regional water plan for its area. The RCWPG is made up of 19 members representing 11 different interest groups, and Region C is made up of all or part of 16 counties in North Central Texas: Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Freestone, Grayson, Henderson (Trinity River Basin portion), Jack, Kaufman, Navarro, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise.
