REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING MONDAY, DECEMBER 10 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY

What: The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting as part of the regional water planning process in North Central Texas. The RCWPG is expected to *take action* on electing new officers for 2008, preparing a letter offering recommendations to the state's Water Conservation Advisory Council, and preparing a letter offering recommendations to the Texas Water Development Board draft rules.

Among other *discussion items*, RCWPG consultants will present an update on the special studies being undertaken during the current biennium, a presentation on water resources projects completed for the Region C area since 1997, and a discussion of water demands and per capita water use.

Members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting and participate in a public comment session during the meeting.

Each water planning group is responsible for preparing and adopting a regional water plan for its area. The RCWPG is made up of 19 members representing 11 different interest groups, and Region C is made up of all or part of 16 counties in North Central Texas: Collin, Cooke, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Freestone, Grayson, Henderson, Jack, Kaufman, Navarro, Parker, Rockwall, Tarrant and Wise.
