### **REGION C WATER PLANNING GROUP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING DECEMBER 6 AT TRINITY RIVER AUTHORITY**

**What:** The Region C Water Planning Group (RCWPG) will hold a public meeting to discuss upcoming steps in the regional water planning process for Region C. Among other agenda items, the RCWPG *will take action* on proposed key water quality parameters, a methodology for evaluating the water management strategies, and the proposed distribution of available supplies to Wholesale Water Providers (WWPs) and Water User Groups (WUGs).

At the meeting, the planning group will begin *discussing* the results (estimated water savings and costs) from the analysis of the conservation strategies and the development of additional reserve water supplies.

Before the RCWPG meeting, there will be a public hearing to discuss a proposed amendment to the 2001 Region C Water Plan requested by the North Texas Municipal Water District. The proposed amendment being considered includes:

- *Adding a water management strategy to include the North Texas Municipal Water District's proposed East Fork Reuse Project*
- *Adding water conservation strategies for North Texas Municipal Water District Members and Customers*

The RCWPG will accept written and oral comments at the public hearing. Written comments may be sent directly to the RCWPG in care of the North Texas Municipal Water District, P.O. Box 2408, Wylie, TX 75098. The deadline for submission of written public comments is January 5, 2005 at 5:00 p.m.
